MATTERS ARISING

Responses received from Clr. Preston These had been distributed to Councillors for their information.

Conditions of roads in area No further information had been received.

Conditions of picnic benches at Tycoch, Deildre No response had been received from Severn Trent.

Code of Conduct Training The clerk had sent an email with the Councils interest in the Code of Conduct Training and was waiting further information.

Provision of bench on cycle route between Cwmbelan and Llanidloes Clr. A.K. Davies has been approached by a further 4 Llanidloes residents regarding the provision of a bench. The Clerk was asked to email Clr. Glyn Preston as this is not within our area. The clerk was asked to write to Llangurig Community Council and inform them.

River Severn Llanidloes Trees are growing in the River Severn below Longbridge which could cause flooding to Victoria Avenue if they are allowed to remain. Trees are also growing out of the bridge.

Road widening scheme by Llanidloes Schools Councillors have had comments at the road widening by the Schools in Llanidloes which is considered to be a waste of money. Lorries are having difficulty passing now as the road has been narrowed. It is concerning that Powys have no say in how the money is spent.

Community Council Vacancy No request has been received by the Returning Officer for Powys County Council and the Council will co-opt a person to fill the vacancy as soon as it is practicable. Councillors agreed to co-opt Mr Geraint Jones, Glynhafren, Old Hall, Llanidloes, for the vacancy and the clerk was asked to write to him.

Cross Border Health Funding and Provision in Powys The clerk has received a copy of recent letter sent from Cty. Cllr. William Powell to the First Minister expressing his serious concerns about the lack of funding for cross-border health services and treatments for the residents of Powys County Council. Councillors agreed with all issues raised in the letter and asked the Clerk to write to the First Minister with our concerns and supporting Clr Powell. Patients that were going to Shrewsbury Hospital are now going to Aberystwyth and patients are having to travel long distances to attend appointments.
