

## MINUTES of a Meeting of LLANIDLOES WITHOUT COMMUNITY COUNCIL

The Minutes of the last meeting, having been circulated, were approved by Councillors, and were signed by the Chairman.

### MATTERS ARISING

**Conditions of roads in the area** No further information has been received.

**Code of Conduct Training** One Voice Wales is offering free funded webinar places on six core modules as well as two free places on a selected number of additional modules. Information and application form available from the clerk.

**Water Gauge, Llanidloes** The clerk read out a response from NRW Wales regarding the condition of the River Severn at the water gauge in Llanidloes. At present they do not consider there to be a significant flood risk at Llanidloes. Councillors were concerned at this decision as there are historic flooding problems in this area and are there correct measurements being taken at the water gauge. The clerk to respond to the NRW.

**Bridge below Clywedog Dam** Nothing further to report.

**Viewing Point overlooking Clywedog Dam** It has been reported that funding has been received for areas to Clywedog Dam, and this area is very overgrown with disabled people parking at this point not being able to appreciate the view.

**Bridge between Tynwtra and Tanhinon** This wooden bridge was replaced in 2010 and is still being used by locals. Clarification was needed as it had been proposed to put it on the Definite map at that time.

### PLANNING APPLICATION

**25/148/DEM** Demolition of existing toilet block.

Location – Public Conveniences, Old Hall, Llanidloes (Hafren Forest).

This was agreed as long as they would be replaced by new facilities.

**Roger Albet Motorsport Event on 20 & 21 November 2025 Closure of paths** This Rally had gone ahead with no problems reported in our area.

**Llanidloes & District Community Transport Scheme** A donation request received from the Llanidloes & District Community Transport Scheme was discussed by Councillors and it was agreed to donate £500.00. This scheme is very well used and needs to be supported by all Councils. Councillors also agreed to donate a further £500.00 in February 2026.

**Urdd Gobaith Cymru Montgomeryshire** A donation request has been received from the Urdd Gobaith Cymru Montgomeryshire to be held in 2026. As it is not being held locally Councillors could not support it.

**Urdd Gobaith Cymru Ynys Mon 2026** A donation request received from the Urdd Gobaith Cymru to be held in Anglesey in 2026 was not supported by the Council.

**Wales Air Ambulance – Community Council Appeal Letter** A donation request received from Wales Air Ambulance was not supported by Councillors. The Wales Air Ambulance is leaving their base in Welshpool so our area will no longer have coverage which is a very bad decision.

**State of Streets in Llanidloes** Concerns have been received by Councillors at the state of the streets in Llanidloes with drains blocked and leaves on the sides of the streets. Trees need pruning back. The clerk to inform our County Councillors.

**Road past Caenocoed, Glan-y-Nant** This road is in a very poor state of repair and a culvert by Caenocoed has been blocked for years. This road in Llangurig Community Council area.

**Road by Clywedog Caravan Park to the Glyn** This road needs to be swept as leaves are covering the road and culverts are blocked. The clerk to report this matter.
