MATTERS ARISING

Conditions of roads in area Clr Franz-Morgan has asked us to provide details of potholes, including task numbers for potholes etc, photos and What3Words reference, and the near postcode and then report them.

Remedial work has been done on the road past Cefngoleugoed and it is a very poor job. Spraying and chipping work has been done and the chipping has failed in some parts, and water will still be a problem on this road.

Road from Llanidloes to Hafren Forest No improvement to the problems to this road. A update received from Clr. Franz-Morgan was given to Councillors.

Clr. Jones asked if Google Maps could change directions for traffic from Aberystwyth to be directed down to Llanidloes and not over the Bwlch which is leading to vehicles going up the back road towards Tynwtra. Two cars suffered flat tyres in the last week and gone to the Jones family for assistance.

Road past Caencoed Nothing has been done.

Road by Clywedog Caravan Park Nothing has been done.

Parking at Llanidloes Hospital A response has been received from Powys Health Board who state that they have recently commenced work on a parking strategy relating to parking across the sites. Out correspondence has been referred for consideration.

Provision of bench at Cwmbelan A bench has not been provided to date. The clerk to email Town Council.

Blocked footpaths Cwmbelan to Llanidloes These are all in Llangurig Community Council area.

Fan Terrace A letter received from Mr Chris Davies, Van Terrace, was read out to the meeting regarding a Barrier to access steps at Fan Terrace. It was believed that these steps were put up by local residents for their convenience and not part of the original structure in the past. Clr. Preston reported that these steps were not the responsibility of Powys County Council. It was agreed that the Council were not responsible for the repair to the barrier.

Invitation to Mayor Making Ceremony An invitation has been extended to the official Mayor Making ceremony which will take place at the Town Hall on 8th May, 2025. Clr. G. Jerman, and Mr & Mrs G. Jones would attend.

Llanidloes Hospital Clr. K. Davies asked why more appointments cannot be arranged in Llanidloes rather than Llanidloes residents travelling to other hospitals such as Machynlleth. The Hospital
